Day guests are welcome at TeenStreet 2017 in Offenburg, Germany. Parents, church leaders, youth workers and friends can visit the TeenStreet site, participate in the programme, share meals and experience TeenStreet for themselves. However, we hope that you understand that our top priority will always be the safety and wellbeing of the teenagers in our care.

What is TeenStreet?

Lunch and dinner are included in the price, as well as participation in some of TeenStreet's main events and programme. Please understand that with our clear focus on the teenagers we cannot provide a comprehensive programme for our day guests. For the same reason, some of the activities are not open to day guests, including the teens' small groups (NET groups). Thank you for your understanding.

Teenagers as day guests: Teenagers under age 17 must be accompanied by a parent, a youth leader or another adult supervisor if they visit TeenStreet as a day guest.

Children: Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

Opening hours

Day guests can visit the TeenStreet site between 08:30 and 22:30. Registration opens at 08:30 and closes at 19:30. When you leave the site before 20:00, you must return your badge to the day guest desk. If you leave after 20:00, please return your badge to the security staff on duty at the main gate.

Note: It is not possible to stay overnight at TeenStreet.
All day guests must leave the site by 22:30.

What to bring:

Please come prepared with cash for the daily registration fee and the badge deposit. Do not forget your photo ID (passport, driver's licence or ID card), and if possible, bring a mobile phone.

Special meeting and guided tour

At 11:00 each day, there will be an information meeting for day guests. This meeting will provide information about TeenStreet and OM, with opportunities for guests to ask questions. It will be followed by a guided tour of the site.

The guided tour will be the **ONLY** opportunity to take a look at the accommodation areas. For the security and protection of our teenagers, day guests are strictly forbidden from entering the accommodation areas at any other time.

The schedule for day guests

09:30 programme in the main hall
11:00 Day guests meeting and guided tour (Shhh-time on site)
13:00 Lunch
14:15 Interact 1.0 / afternoon programme (see below)
16:00 Interact 2.0 / afternoon programme (see below)
17:45 Evening meal
19:15 Throne Room (worship time and prayer)
20:30 Interact 3.0 (Visit the OM stand, the bookshop, the cafés, etc.)
22:30 All day guests must leave the site

Interact

During the afternoons and after the evening meeting a wide variety of activities are offered, including seminars, workshops, art and sports programmes. Please note that seminars, workshop etc. are primarily reserved for participants of TeenStreet. The bookstore stocks a wide variety of titles, and café areas are a popular place to relax. Check out the exhibition area on site to learn about the work of OM worldwide, as well as other exciting ministries.

The badge

For security reasons, all day guests must wear their badge visibly at all times. The badge is valid for only one day. The badge is NOT transferable. If you lose your badge, a replacement will cost €10. You receive your badge from the Day Guest staff at the main entrance. When leaving the site you must return your badge, and your deposit will be returned to you.

Photography at TeenStreet

Please note that in the main hall photography is only permitted from your seat. We ask you to avoid taking photos of individual teens. The TeenStreet staff reserve the right to ask guests to stop taking photos if this activity disrupts the TeenStreet experience for our young people or causes distress in any way.

Code of conduct (CLS)

TeenStreet is a one-week event that brings together young people from around the world with different cultural and denominational backgrounds. We have developed a code of conduct called the Community Lifestyle Statement (CLS) to ensure harmony and safety throughout the week.

The CLS also applies to day guests. In particular, we would like to emphasise that smoking and drinking alcohol within the site are strictly prohibited. Please read and sign the CLS on site, as your commitment to abide by this code of conduct during your visit.
